## APMGFA PRACTITIONER TRAINING

The APMGFA training program has been specifically designed to provide the practitioner with hands on training and a theoretical background to provide quality products and services to their clients. The training is a requirement of the APMGFA certification criteria which is administered by the MGF Register.

Precert A training provides the necessary 16 hours of preliminary training for certification of Medical Grade Footwear Practitioners at the Retail Pedorthist Level. This course will be held in Dee Why on 13/14 February 2010.

Precert B training provides the necessary 32 hours of preliminary training for certification of Medical Grade Footwear Practitioners at the Certified Pedorthist Level. This course will be held in Dee Why on 13/14/27/28 February 2010.

Applications in Pedorthics is the PFA approved course to complete the requirements to become a Certified Pedorthist. This course will be held at LaTrobe University in Melbourne 5 – 16 July 2010.

Training is a mixture of hands on assessment and lectures covering footwear, medical conditions and practice management, and is recommended for all people involved in supplying medical grade footwear and advice. It also leads to the independent certification and registration as a Medical Grade Footwear Practitioner. Applicants are advised to check the full certification criteria on our web site for complete details of requirements.
